GUIDELINES FOR SUBMISSION

WHO CAN APPLY

- Individuals or groups 12 - 25 years old
- Teachers and art instructors may apply on behalf of a group of students
- Only one original work of art per person will be accepted
- Proof of vaccination required for participation

VISUAL ART

- Must be approximately 11”x17” and framed or mounted on foam core for display on an easel*
 - Work must be delivered to MMA by the end of March 17th 2022, exact times and dates of delivery time slots TBA
 - Work must be labeled (back or bottom) at time of drop-off. *Please fill out application information exactly as you would like it to appear on the identifying label at the exhibition.*
- *Other forms of visual art may be considered for presentation upon request

PERFORMING ART

- Works must be 10 minutes or less
- SpectorDance will provide a sound system
- Music must be delivered on a thumb drive to event organizers March 17th, 2022
- Performing artists must attend a tech rehearsal prior to the festival.. Artists will need to arrive 20 minutes before their scheduled time slot, which will be assigned. Specifics TBA

- High-resolution photographs of artist and/or work for publicity

- Performing artists must be available for pre-event Tech Rehearsal date TBA
- Artists must give SpectorDance permission to use any photographs or video footage taken at the 2nd MOAF
- Artists must be able to arrive before and/or stay after the event to assist with the set-up and clean-up of their visual art display or performance
- Share the provided flyer/information with friends and contacts

- SpectorDance reserves the right to refuse a work of art for any reason
- Neither MMA or SpectorDance are responsible for any damage to artwork that may occur during storage for, or display at, the festival.
