

SpectorDance's New Safety Policies for July 2020 In Person Classes

All Dancers and Parents should read and review these policies before the start of their first class.

- **Going forward, a new Release of Liability Form is now required to be on file for all dancers who take in-studio (in person) classes. This form must be turned in prior to or immediately upon check-in on your first day of camp/intensive.** Attached to this email is the new Release of Liability Forms (one for students under 18 and one for students who are over 18).
- Before leaving your house, make sure that neither you nor any members of your household show signs of sickness as listed in the Release of Liability Form. Please use the bathroom before leaving home and bring a large, full water bottle. All common areas will be closed including lobbies, dressing rooms and the office. Please have your dancewear on before you arrive.
- Please arrive 5 minutes early for drop off and pick up.
- Upon arrival, please line up (6ft apart) for check-in along the outside of the building (see tape marks). Masks must be worn while waiting outside and during the check-in process. Before entering the studio your temperature will be taken and you will be asked to use hand sanitizer. Teachers and assistants will be wearing masks the whole time and we ask that any parents picking up or dropping off do the same if they come to the door. Please only dancers and staff inside the studio. Dancers limit the items that you bring into the studio, only bring what is needed for class.
- Once dancers enter the building, they will place their dance bag or any other items along the back wall of the studio while keeping 6 feet apart. The dancer will then look for an open socially distanced taped space holder on the floor of the studio. This will be your dance space for the entire class or for multiple classes in a row for that day. Dancers should keep their masks on at all times.
- After finding their dance space, dancers may take a bare to their space. Only one dancer per bare will be allowed. Dance Bares will be cleaned before and after every class.
- While dancing, dancers should keep their masks on at all times if possible. We understand this might be difficult due to exercising. If needed dancers can pull covering down pass their nose to get fresh air, but we are asking that you try to keep mouths covered at all time is possible.
- Please be sure dancers are picked up on time.
- **IMPORTANT TO NOTE: We will be following State and County orders. If we have to shut down again, all classes will still go on via Zoom. Zoom links will automatically be sent out to all students who were taking in-studio classes. There will be no makes ups offered and no refunds on tuition.**
